

# PrEP Assistance Program (PrEP-AP), California Department of Public Health

## COVERS COSTS RELATED TO PREP AND PEP:

- **Medication co-pays.**
- **Out-of-pocket costs for medical visits, HIV/STI screenings, and treatment.**
- **PEP for eligible clients with a recent HIV exposure (less than 72 hours).**

PrEP-AP is for CA residents who make below 500% of the Federal Poverty Level. PrEP-AP is free and available regardless of legal status.

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## ACCESS PrEP-AP

- Schedule an appointment at a PrEP-AP enrollment center. Find one near you at: [TinyURL.com/CAPrEPAP](https://TinyURL.com/CAPrEPAP).
- Gather eligibility documents. See the checklist at: [TinyURL.com/CAPrEPAP](https://TinyURL.com/CAPrEPAP).
- Once enrolled, schedule an appointment with a PrEP-AP medical provider.
- PrEP-AP may cover PrEP costs for insured people who qualify. Additional payment assistance options: [PleasePrEPMe.org/Payment](https://PleasePrEPMe.org/Payment).
- PrEP-AP will help uninsured people enroll into Medi-Cal.
- Kaiser members who qualify may also use PrEP-AP.
- Re-enroll in PrEP-AP every twelve months.
